As a CNA, responsibilities focus on providing professional and dependable caregiver assistance within all aspects of daily living for elderly and disabled persons. Including but not limited to:

- Provide for activities of daily living by assisting with serving meals, feeding residents as necessary; ambulating, turning, and positioning residents; providing fresh water and nourishment between meals
- Check resident vital signs and weight; recording intake and output information
- Provide residents' personal hygiene by giving baths, backrubs, shampoos, and shaves; assist with travel to the bathroom, bedpans and urinals
- Provide resident comfort by utilizing resources and materials; transport residents; answer residents' call lights and requests; report observations of the resident to nursing supervisor

Required Skills:

- Current certification as a Certified Nurse Aide in the State of Wisconsin is required. Candidates who have successfully completed a 120-hour training program and are waiting to complete the state exam will also be considered
- All candidates must have a proven attendance record, good customer service skills, the desire to work with those in need of assistance, and work well in a team environment
