- Safely transport patients to and from appointments outside of the facility, which includes properly securing wheelchairs, ensuring proper use of seatbelts, and manually transporting the patient to the appropriate appointment area, in facility owned vehicle
- Do performance checks of company vehicles such as ensuring brakes, tires, lights, etc., are in proper working order
- Maintain the transportation schedule in a timely manner
- Maintain appropriate fuel levels in the vehicle, and fill the vehicle with fuel when needed
- Keep vehicle interiors clean for passengers

- Must be at least 24 years old
- Must have CPR/First Aid training certification (will provide training if not certified)
- Must be willing to work casual/on-call fill-in for this position
